Gymnastics - The Nimble Ninjas! — Ages/Time/Cost: 4 to 6, 2:10 to 3:10, \$250

Mini's — Ages/Time/Cost: 4 to 6, 2:10 to 3:10, \$215

Students will use different mediums, including watercolor pencils, tempura/acrylic paints, colored pencils, and oil pastels. Chess Academy — Ages/Time/Cost: 5 to 11, 3:15 to 4:15, \$225
